

Rent Policy - COVID-19

March 24, 2020

Foundation Communities is immediately implementing the following policy to help residents stay in their housing if they experience a reduction in income or loss of employment due to COVID-19:

- Payment Plans for residents affected by COVID-19. Resident(s) will provide qualified written
 evidence that clearly demonstrates the connection between those measures or events with their
 reduction in/loss of income. A COVID Income Verification Form must be completed by office staff.
 Resident(s) should provide all documentation prior to the late payment deadline as stated on the
 lease.
- 2. After verifying the information provided and assessing the need, Foundation Communities will agree to a written Payment Plan Agreement up to six months. Resident must sign the Payment Agreement Plan.
- 3. Late fees will be waived for residents that qualify for the Payment Plan Agreement.
- 4. Renewal rental increases for upcoming expiring leases will be temporarily suspended.
- 5. Refer residents to available rental assistance.
